Year 2: Joseph and Darcey both have a bronze and silver Mathletics award and Lucas a football medal

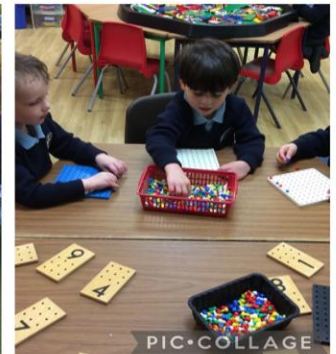
