I cannot wait to see all these costumes on World book dress up day on **Friday 8th March!**



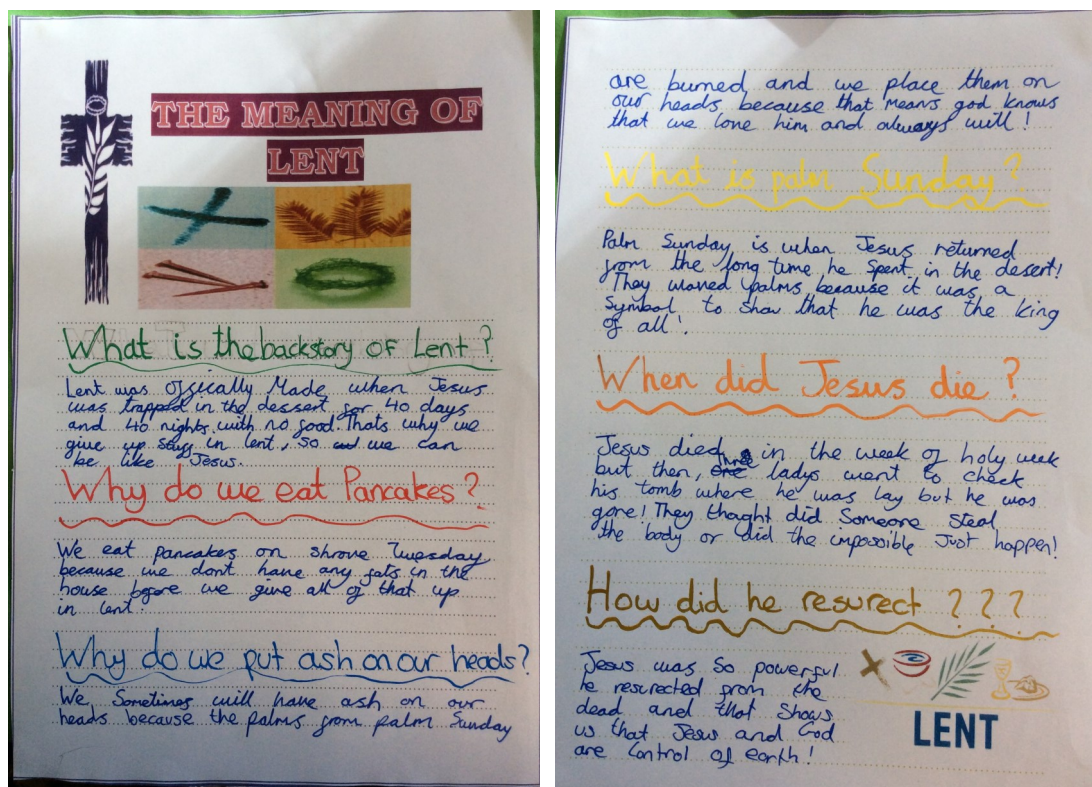

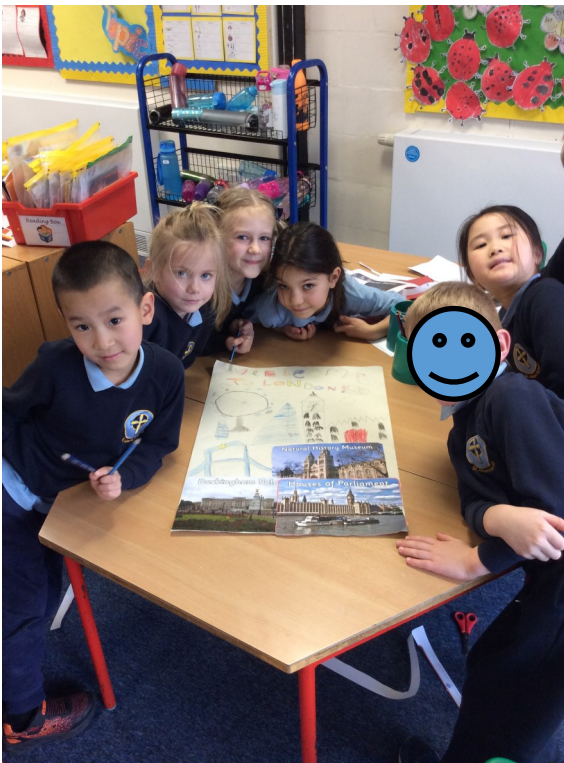
## Year 5 Greek Topic
