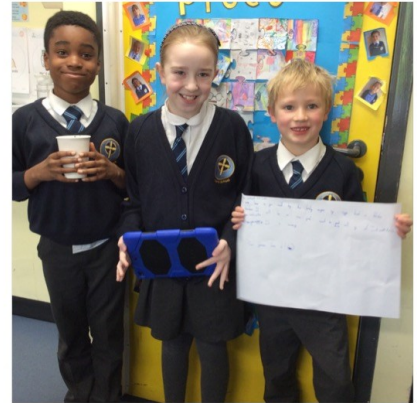
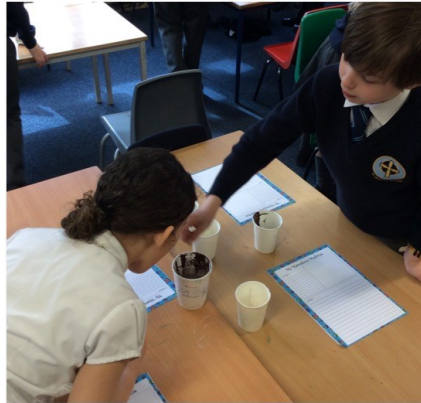

Year 3 - Marvellous Medicine

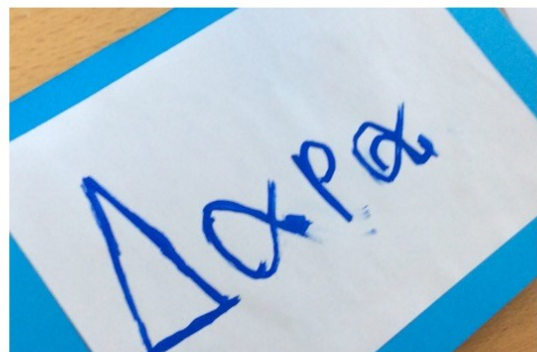
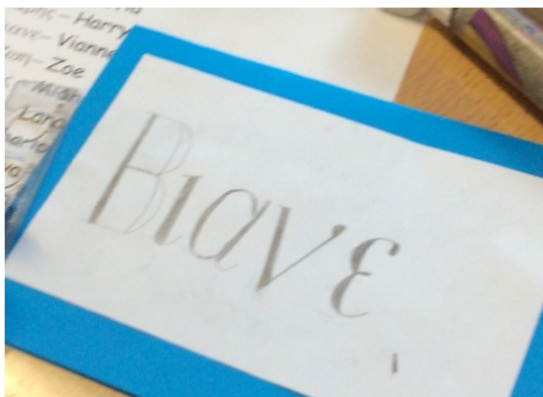
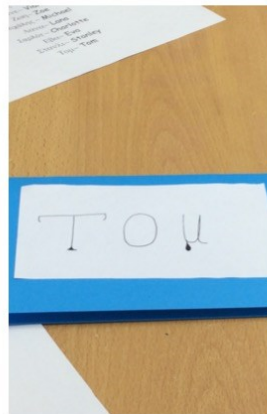
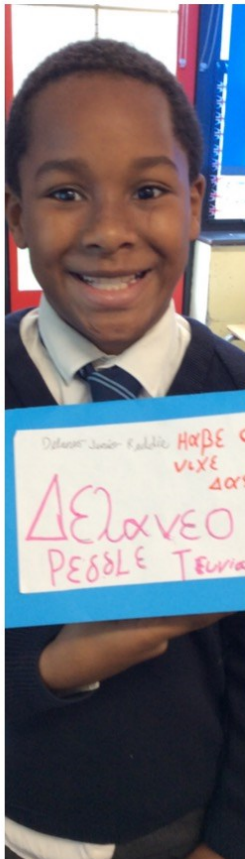
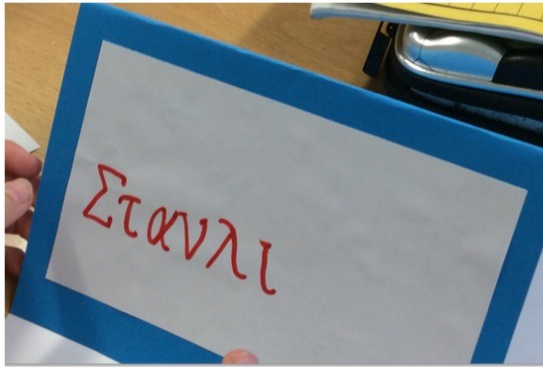
Year 3 were very mischievous this week. They made their very own Marvellous Medicine to finish their class book 'George's Marvellous Medicine'.

They then went around the school persuading all the staff members to drink their wonderful creation. I think they were very persuasive!



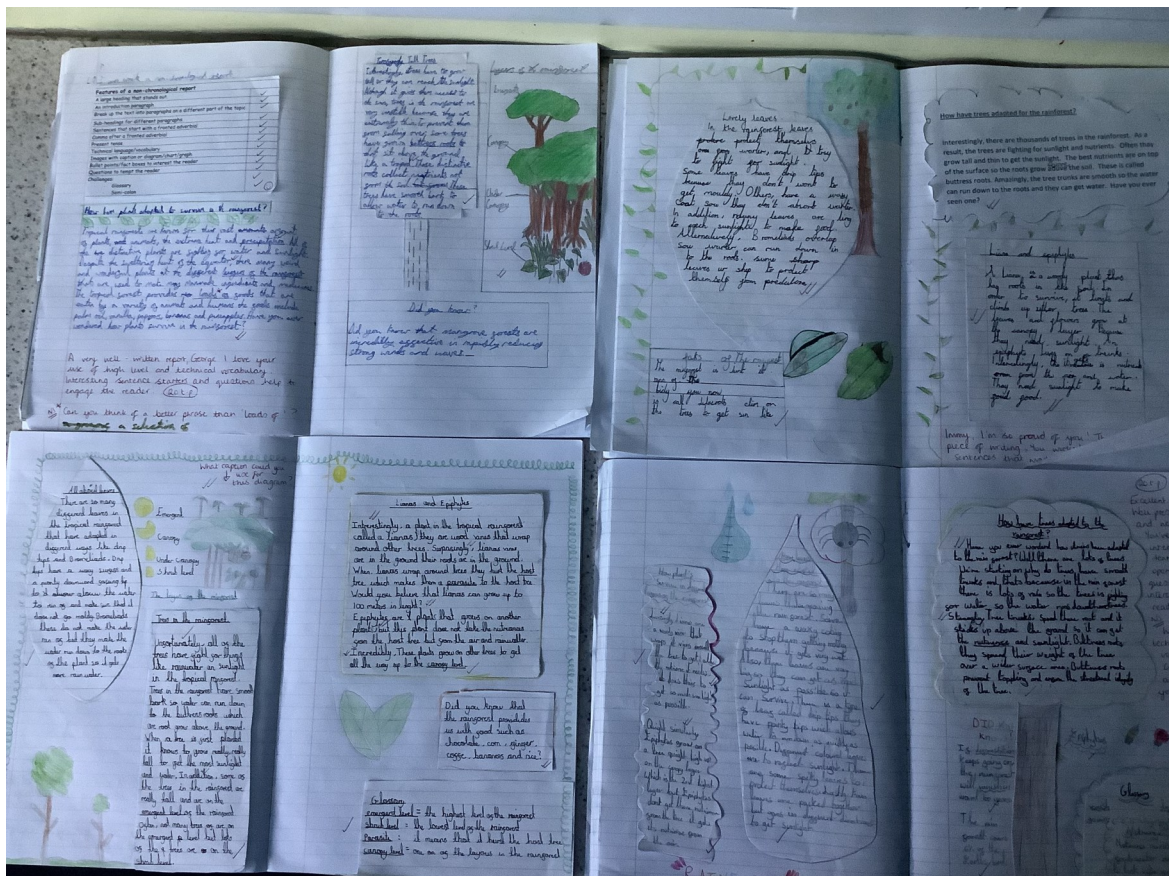
Year 5 - Greek Alphabet

Taskmaster

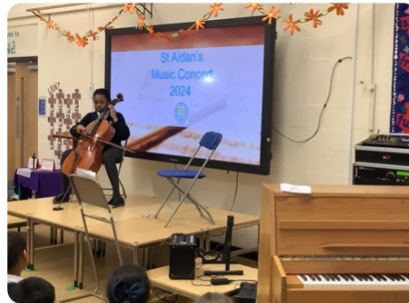

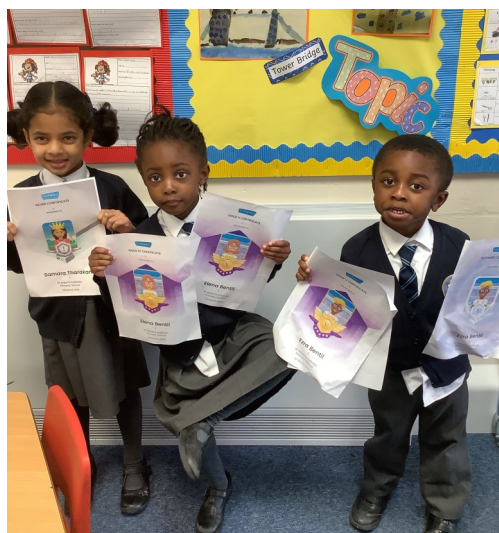
This Week's Awards at St Aidan's
