The focus today is to use different measures to fill the same container.

#### **Activity 1**

Fill a washing up bowl or bucket with water

Take an empty jug

Fill the jug with water from the washing up bowl using a small cup as your measure.

Draw the jug and write how many cupfuls of water filled the jug

#### **Activity 2**

Using the same jug now fill it with water again using a spoon as your measure

Draw the jug and write how many spoonfuls of water filled the jug

Ask the question Why does the jug hold more spoonfuls of water and less cupfuls?

Please write your answer in a sentence.
