


Hi Year 2, happy Thursday!

RE – Treasures

Below are a series of statements. They are thoughts, actions, things that happen in our world. For each one, I want you to talk about or write about whether God wants this and, as always in Year 2, more importantly WHY.

If you are talking about this, I think doing all the statements is a good amount of work. If you are writing, maybe choose 5-7 statements (though you can do all of them if you want to). If you want to and have a printer, print the statements out and sort them into two piles.
